The conference theme, Diversity in Advanced Practice Nursing: Boundless Horizons will explore the following:

- Practice informing research, education, leadership and administration.
- Research exploring practice, education, leadership and administration.
- Education influencing practice, research, leadership and administration.
- Leadership and administration guiding research, practice and education.

This conference will create an extensive gathering of health professionals from across Canada. Together, advanced practice nurses, educators, researchers, policy-makers, students and managers/administrators will explore topics related to evidence and practice. Presentations may be in either oral or poster formats as outlined below:

- Poster Presentation: A visual display. Author(s) must be present. Designated poster session times will be included within the program. Presenting author(s) will be required to stand by the poster during this assigned presentation time.

Guidelines for Abstract Submission

- Submissions for either oral or poster presentations may be based on completed research or related projects representing examples of innovative advanced practice in keeping with the conference themes.
- An individual may submit more than one abstract.
- There is no fee to submit an abstract(s).
- Applicants not accepted for oral presentations may be offered the option of a poster presentation.
- Submission deadline has been extended to March 31st, 2011.
- Successful applicants will be notified by email no later than April 8th, 2011.
- Successful applicants must confirm their acceptance by April 15th, 2011.
